The fixtures for the summer season of matches is here.

Every month, the captain will send out a reminder to all seniors to update their availability of matches using IG. The next section will show you how to do this in IG. The examples are all taken using the laptop version of IG. You can do the same things using a smart phone going to the main club web site. You cannot use the stand-alone IG app many of you have been using to book tee times.

Setting Availability in IG

You first need to log onto the main club IG web site. Any problems doing this, please refer to the club manager as she manages access to the web site. Then click Competitions and from the drop down list, select Matches as shown.



This will then take you to the screen to select the squads you have been allocated to. Again, if you cannot see Seniors, refer to the club manager. Then select Set Availability against the Seniors squad.



You can then see all the seniors matches for 2021 and for each one you can click the round buttons on the right to show Yes, No or Maybe. You can change these at any time.



When you have entered all those you can, scroll right down to the bottom and click Save Availability



This will then allow the captain to select teams for the next month. You will then rec eive an e-mail if you have been selected to play or set as a reserve.

If you have been selected but then you are not able to play, as can happen, please let the captain know as soon as possible by e-mail.
