Lutterworth Seniors Winter Wednesday Competition Series

For obvious reasons, the upcoming winter series of Wednesday competitions will be like no other. The aim will be :-

- To replicate the winter series of previous years of Wednesday competitions as best we can
- The draw being done remotely
- Operate the financial side of things in a 'cashless' manner.

Draw/playing procedure

The seniors have tee times already allocated for each Wednesday during the winter season. As we cannot meet to make selections, issue score cards, collate results and allocate prize money, the following will be the way things will operate.

- E-mail the captain, Bob Howes, by the end of the Monday before the Wednesday competition if you wish to participate.
- On Tuesday afternoon, the draw will be done, match cards prepared and tee times allocated. The allocated tee times will be e-mailed to all seniors as well as being published on the Seniors website.
- When you arrive in the car park, the captain will be on-hand to issue score cards. The captain will hence always be in the last group.
- After playing, please leave all completed score cards inside the club house in one place.
- These will be collected by the captain and processed some time later. The results and prize monies will be published on the Seniors web site.

Finance and Prizes

It is intended to maintain individual accounts for all participants with the usual £2 being charged for each of the weekly events and, as in previous years, half of the monies collected will be paid out as prizes and the remainder will go to the senior's coffers.

There are 24 events planned for the winter season and so the total outlay for the winter would be £48 for someone playing every time. It is felt that a bill for this amount at the end of the season might be a bit daunting and so two options will be offered:

- 1. Participants can pay a £20 deposit at the beginning of the season and then the account will be settled up at the end with any unused portion being reimbursed or any deficit being billed.
- 2. Run the whole season on credit with full settlement at the end.

Please let Norman Beaumont, the treasurer, know which option you wish to take. Remember to let him know about all direct bank transfers.

Any prize money gathered throughout the season will, of course, be credited to the individual accounts.
